
### 1. Course/Module Content & Structure

The majority of teachers strongly agree (65%) while 35% just agree.









## 1.2. I understand the content of this training session.

17 teachers out of 21 consider material's sequence ver easy to follow.









### 1.4. Sufficient time was allowed for each topic.

71.4% of the teachers strongly agreed that the content prepared them very well, 23.8% agreed while the 4.8% was neutral.




### 2. Delivery Methods

71.4% of the teachers strongly agreed that the electronic media assisted them very well, 14.28% agreed and other 14.28% was neutral.








## 2.2. The delivery methods were suitable for the content of this training


85.5% of the teachers strongly agree that the delivery methods were suitable for the content of this training while 9.5% just agree.

# 2.4. The method used by the trainer made the content clear and easy to understand.


66.6% of teachers strongly agree that this method makes contents clear and understadable while 33.4% just agree.
